As we approach the end of the summer, I hope that all of you had a good summer and were able to enjoy a lot of your outdoor activities in spite of some very warm temperatures. Since the last newsletter, there have been the some significant changes at Sunoco: the pending sale of the company to Energy Transfer Partners, the pending Philadelphia Refinery joint venture with The Carlyle Group, and the sale of the Marcus Hook propylene facilities to Braskem. We all have a lot of questions regarding how these sales will impact the current retirees but until the transactions actually close and the details of the sales are available, definitive answers to our questions may not be possible. DVSA has been in contact with appropriate Sunoco representatives and have posed a number of questions about the impact of these transactions on retirees. As soon as answers to our questions become available we will pass that along to our membership.

The DVSA board continues to look at our cost structure and work on balancing our costs with expected revenue. Where members have the ability to receive communications/newsletters, our largest single cost category, by email, opting for email will help reduce DVSA costs. Printing and postage is the single largest cost for DVSA.
